

Digital Dunes Liability Waiver & \$500 Hole-in-One or 50/50 Challenge Addendum

General Facility Guidelines

(The original facility safety and conduct rules remain intact as in the original waiver document, including equipment rules, behavior standards, cancellation policy, and responsibility for damages.)

Liability Waiver

(The original liability waiver provisions remain intact, including full Release of Liability, Assumption of Risk, Indemnity, Acknowledgment of Risks, Injuries by/to Third Parties, Insurance, Representations, Basis of Bargain, Choice of Law, Model Release, Jury Trial Waiver, COVID-19 clause, and Parent/Guardian Liability Waiver.)

\$500 Hole-in-One or 50/50 Challenge Addendum

This Addendum supplements the existing waiver and applies specifically to participation in the Hole-in-One or 50/50 Challenge (the “Contest”).

Eligibility

1. Must be 18 years or older. Minors may participate only with parent/guardian consent and prize claim.
2. Open to all except:
 - Professional golfers
 - Professional long-drive competitors
 - Professional putt-putt/mini-golf competitors
3. All equipment must meet PGA standards. Staff may inspect and disallow non-conforming equipment.

Entry

1. \$5 per ball or \$20 for five balls (non-refundable).
2. Standalone contest, separate from simulator play.
3. Entry requires acknowledgment of this Addendum as part of the Digital Dunes Waiver.

Contest Play

1. Standard contest hole is Payne's Valley #19 (~110–140 yards), Sunday Pin Placement, No Wind, unless otherwise designated by staff.
2. All shots must be witnessed by staff and video recorded by staff or an onlooker.
3. Practice balls are \$5 each.
4. Participants may win only once per calendar year.

Winning Criteria

1. Hole-in-One: The ball must remain in the hole to count as a hole-in-one.
2. Simulator Malfunction:
 - If a swing is not registered, no attempt is counted.
 - If this occurs more than 5 consecutive times on the same ball, staff will inspect.
 - If caused by player fault → counts as a miss.
 - If simulator fault → refund of entry fee for that ball.
3. Shot Validity: A shot is valid if (a) the simulator registers the ball movement, or (b) staff determines a swing occurred consistent with PGA standards.
4. 50/50 Ball: To qualify, the ball must come to rest and remain on the green.

Prize Structure

1. Hole-in-One Prize: \$500 cash.
2. 50/50 Prize:
 - 50% of the entry pool is retained by Digital Dunes.
 - 50% of the entry pool is distributed among the winner(s).
 - If multiple players tie for closest-to-the-hole, the players share the winners' portion equally.
3. Limit: One win per person per calendar year.
4. Payment: Within 30 days.
5. Tax liability is the sole responsibility of the participant.

Risk, Liability & Conduct

1. Staff may deny entry to any participant for safety reasons.
2. All provisions of the general Digital Dunes Waiver apply equally to Contest play.
3. Participants grant Digital Dunes rights to use their name, likeness, and video footage for promotional purposes without compensation.

Disputes

1. Staff decisions on validity, rules, and prizes are final.
2. All disputes resolved by binding arbitration under Florida law.
3. Venue: State of Florida.

Administration

1. Simulator logs all swings; staff record results digitally to the website.
2. Video records are maintained for verification and promotion.
3. Refunds only for confirmed simulator malfunction or staff discretion.
